Mr. Georg Oberle, born on 29.08.50 in Duesseldorf, Germany, joined the GTZ-MLP in Angola on 01.08.97 initially as a Senior Mechanic at the Mbanza Congo (Zaire Province) project site. He was subsequently promoted in October 1997 to the position of Workshop Manager, Mbanza Congo, and was responsible for the supervision of local staff repairing and maintaining the project vehicles, trucks, generators, and motorcycles.

Due to illnesses, vacations, and absences, during the period of October 1997 – April 1998, Mr. Oberle, in addition to his own duties, assumed the responsibilities of the Field Coordinator and the Road/Bridge/Construction Supervisor. These additional duties included:

- Staff management and construction site supervision of project sites being rehabilitated (schools, health center, bridges and roads)
- Administrative reporting, petty-cash control, returnee registration, local logistic operations management, and aid materials distribution supervision.

After closure of the Mbanza Congo Workshop, Mr. Oberle was transferred to the main UNHCR/GTZ-MLP Workshop in Viana/Luanda as Sr. Mechanic. He supervised the repair & maintenance operations of the Workshop and acted as Workshop Manager during absence.

Due to a downsizing of the Workshop before completing the project in May 1999, we are forced to release Mr. Oberle as per 31.03.99. We can, however, recommend him as a very resourceful and able mechanic. He has good local knowledge and contacts, and has also been of great assistance to our procurement section. He is an honest and willing worker, and we wish Mr. Oberle good luck and fortune in his desire to remain in Angola.
